The History department is pleased to offer your child the opportunity to attend an exciting in- school workshop to support their GCSE History course, on Thursday 6th June 2024.

As you may be aware, your child is currently studying the Historic environment of World War One - an integral part of the GCSE History curriculum and paper 1 examination. This workshop, led by expert re-enactors will provide your child with a unique and engaging learning experience to further support their studies. The workshop will focus on weapons and wounds of World War One and provide students with an opportunity to handle a range of weapons and artefacts.

This hands-on experience seems sure to captivate students and enhance their understanding of the types of wounds doctors and surgeons had to deal with. In fact, one of the high lights of the workshop is the exploration of the use of gas during the war. Students will have the chance to participate in gas mask drills and gain a first-hand experience of the effects of gases such as Phosgene and Mustard gas. Additionally, there will be a comprehensive walk-through of the chain of evacuation, including a role play exercise wtheire students will have the chance to dress in a Tommy's uniform and experience being wounded on the battlefield. This exercise will allow them to understand the evacuation process and the roles of various medical staff along the way, as well as innovations such as the Thomas Splint, blood transfusions and X-ravs.

The workshop promises to be highly informative and engaging, providing our students with a wealth of information and a broader understanding of the historical context.
