

A guide to registering for your Lateral Flow Test

All students at Newlands Girls' School will be offered 2 LFD tests, commencing September 1st.

We will publish a calendar of dates for when your daughter will be tested. The day your daughter has her first test, she will bring home a Registration Card with 1 set of 3 barcodes as well as 2 barcodes from her test that day. She should keep these safe, as a separate barcode is required for each test. Please follow the link on the card to complete the online registration. You must register the first test within 24 hours of having it, but future tests can be registered 24 hours before or 24 hours after taking the test.

You should start on this page:

Register a coronavirus test (lateral flow test)

This type of test checks if you're currently infectious with coronavirus. It's called a lateral flow test.

Your sample will be taken and tested at the site and you'll get your results the same day.

To complete this form, you'll need:

- the barcode for the test you're registering (it starts with the letter 'L')
- a mobile number (for you or the person you're registering it for)

! Only use this service if the barcode on your test kit starts with the letter 'L'. If your barcode does not start with 'L', you need to [register your test kit using a different service](#).

You will then have a series of questions to answer (the information in blue boxes is a guide for some answers)

Who are you registering a test for?

This should be 'pupil's name'

Sign up for a coronavirus testing account

On this page, if you know your NHS number, you can log in using that. Otherwise click on 'Register without using NHS login'.

Enter the unique test kit barcode

On this page you can either scan one barcode from your set of 3 barcodes, or manually input the 11-digit code.

What's the test site's ID or name?

Our site ID is NGSL, you should get a drop-down list which will have Newlands Girls' School on it.

Are you doing 7-day repeat testing?

The answer to this should be 'No'. We will not be doing the 7-day repeat testing at Newlands (East Berks Health Authority guidance)

When will you take the coronavirus test?

The options for this are: 'Today' (and the date), 'Tomorrow' (and the date), or 'A different date'. Select 'Today'. You should then put in the rough time that you took the test.

What's your name?

What's your date of birth?

What's your gender?

What is your ethnic group?

Do you travel to nursery, work or a place of education?

Select your area of work

This should be 'Teaching and Education'.

What is your occupation?

What is the name of your employer?

Do you currently have coronavirus symptoms?

This should be 'No, I do not currently have any of these symptoms'. If you have symptoms, you should not come to school.

What country do you live in?

What's the first line of your address and home postcode?

Do you have an email address?

What's your mobile number?

Do you have a landline phone number?

These 3 questions are to provide the service with a way to contact you with your result. They will contact you whatever your result, within half an hour of the school uploading the results. Newlands will not contact you unless your result is positive.

Do you know your NHS number?

Have you had a coronavirus vaccine?

This should be 'No'.

Check your answers

Read through your answers to make sure they are accurate

Security check

Complete the CAPTCHA security check

Complete the security check to submit your application

Save and continue

Congratulations, you have completed the registration. This is by far the most difficult part of the process. Actually having the test will take about 30 seconds.
