- Start by lightly sketching out the face shape.

- Draw light lines across your picture and drawing to help you get the eyes and nose in the right place.

- Work from your picture to add each facial feature, checking as you go.
- Gradually build up shading across the features.

- Watch part 1 and 2 videos to help you though the task. You can pause and work through at your own pace.


