In school, the timings for the final week will follow the normal school day. Term will finish at midday on Friday 18th July.

As your daughter will be involved in Sports Day on **Friday 11th July**, can I ask that she wear either her **house t-shirt or a t-shirt in her house colour as well as her PE kit**, including her PE shorts and trainers. Students are also permitted to wear face paint in their house colour on this day if they choose to. There will also be a range of confectionery for sale during the day and students are therefore invited to bring in some small change with them if they would like to purchase these.

Pupils are permitted to wear non-uniform clothes for Enrichment Days which begin on **Tuesday 16th July**, however, for the careers day we ask that students wear smart casual clothing which is appropriate for an office environment. The rules for hair, make-up and accessories will be the same as for a normal school day

For the remaining days, students should wear clothing and footwear suitable for some physical activities. She should also bring sun cream, a sun hat and a bottle of water each day.
