As your daughter will be involved in Sports Day on Friday 11th July, can I ask that she wear either her house t-shirt or a t-shirt in her house colour as well as her PE kit, including her PE shorts and trainers. Students are also permitted to wear face paint in their house colour on this day if they choose to. There will also be a range of confectionery for sale during the day and students are therefore invited to bring in some small change with them if they would like to purchase these.

Pupils are permitted to wear non-uniform clothes for Enrichment Days which begin on **Tuesday 16th July**, however, on each day there will be some physical activities and therefore students should wear clothing and footwear suitable for this.
