Parent Support Worker (Mrs L. Mack) Employed to provide practical advice and bespoke training for parents and to support them at academic and pastoral meetings.	£3,300.00
Additional Study Support Implementation of the 'Step Up' and 'Shape Up' raising attainment programmes.	£7,740.55
Educational Resourcing To provide subsidies for trips, visits, enrichment activities and revision materials.	£500.00
