

Financial Aid for Climate Change

Last week's Year 12 PSHE lesson explored citizenship in relation to the environment. It was a timely reminder about the impact of climate change in light of Boris Johnson's renewed call for richer countries to increase financial support to poorer ones fighting this issue. On 20th September, the Prime Minister said he was "increasingly frustrated" at the support offered to countries hit hard by global warming at the UN gathering in New York. Mr Johnson further said "history will judge" countries who "lacked the courage to step up" when recalling the 2009 agreement that the developed world would provide \$100bn a year by 2020 to help poorer countries deal with the effects of climate change, and how, in 2019, the figure had only reached just over \$79bn, which clearly needs to change. 


**World Contraception Day**


