- 3rd Place - Leena Bashier, Year 12

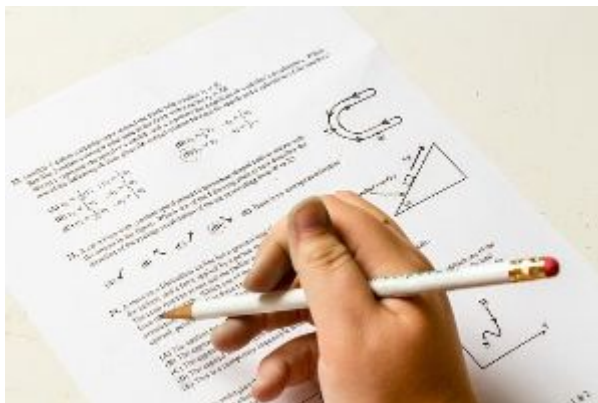


The Lumière Film Society

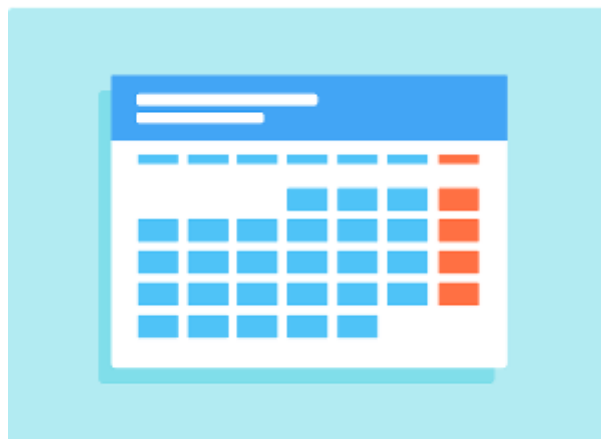
