Reminder: Holocaust Educational Trust


We are excited to be able to share an opportunity for our Sixth Form students to be able to participate in an online initiative which has been launched by the Holocaust Educational Trust. *Lessons from Auschwitz Online* is available to all state schools and colleges in England with a post-16 provision. Participating students will have access to the new online learning platform to complete self-guided learning modules, and use cutting edge virtual reality technology to view key sites at the Auschwitz-Birkenau State Memorial and Museum. Participants will also hear from a Holocaust survivor who will share their testimony and answer questions. The course will be led by specialist educators who will guide students throughout the project and students will be expected to attend three online Live Sessions. Spaces are extremely limited so please could any student who is interested in taking part email Mrs Bretherton as soon as possible.



The Lumière Film Society


