NEWLANDS GIRLS' SCHOOL - UNIFORM REGULATIONS – 2019 – Years 7 - 11

Parents are asked to ensure that their daughter's uniform conforms to the list below.

- V-necked jumper Blue with 1 grey stripe for Years 7-9 and blue with 2 grey stripes for Year 10.
- Blouse White fitted revere collar, three quarter length sleeve/short sleeve blouse. Fashion blouses or boys' shirts are not acceptable. If a T-shirt is worn underneath the blouse, it must be white.
- Kilt Designed to be worn "long", i.e. well below the knee. "Rolling" of the kilt at the waist is not permitted.
- **Trousers** Regulation school flat front with straight leg same colour as school jacket. (*These are only available from Goyals and School Days Direct*).
- Jacket Dark charcoal grey with school logo on the lapel.
- Socks White, grey or black knee or ankle-length socks
- Tiahts Plain arev. flesh-coloured or black (not patterned)

Please note, girls may wear socks or tights, but not both. Also, leggings are not permitted.

- Shoes
 Low-heeled (maximum height 1.5 inches/4 cm) black (only) shoes.
 Platform soles and sling backs are not safe for wear in school.
 <u>Trainers are not acceptable</u>.
- **Summer Dress** (optional): This may be worn with the jacket during Terms 5 and 6. (This is now available from Goyals and School Days Direct)
- School Scarf (optional)

Muslim girls may wear the uniform head covering in plain black only, with a plain fixture to attach the Hijab. Decorative brooches or pins should not be used. The Hijab should be worn tucked under the shirt collar.

Special Purpose Uniform

- **Goggles/** Protection for Science experiments. **Case**
- House This will not be able to be purchased until your daughter starts at Newlands and she finds out to which House she has been assigned.
- PE Kit PE kit is compulsory and for reasons of hygiene a special kit is needed: Red shirt, red sweatshirt, black skort, black jogging bottoms, black Lycra cycling shorts with maximum leg length of 6", trainers, football boots, shin pads and a gum shield (both compulsory), red knee-length hockey socks, white ankle socks, swimming towel, black one-piece swimming costume, white swimming cap (for swimmers of more than 25 metres), otherwise red cap.

Optional items: Hockey stick, long sleeve black base layer top, waterproof jacket and tennis racket (<u>summer term only</u>). (It is possible to purchase a second-hand hockey stick from the PE Department). Goggles are recommended for swimming.

All PE kit and towels must be boldly embroidered, or name-taped, with pupil's full name on the front top left side of the shirt, bottom left side of skort, as shown below:

We realise that it is expensive to equip a pupil to start secondary school. If you prefer to spread the cost, we suggest that the jumper could be purchased later when the weather gets colder. Summer PE equipment is not needed in the first term.
