We are also very proud of our students' success rate at A-Level with the majority of grades being A*-C.

Science is a key subject within the school with all students taking either Separate or Combined Science at GCSE. In 2023, 81% of students achieved grades 9-4, putting the department among the top schools in the country. At A-Level, 73% achieved A*-B in Biology, 70% achieved A*-B in Chemistry and 80% achieved A*-C in Physics.
