Priorities for Year 9


- Attendance and Punctuality


Pastoral Development Programme

Attendance



Last year's Y11 who had attendance above 95% averaged a grade 6, with an even higher average grade in Maths and English

95% = 50 missed lessons

Student who attended 90 to 95% of the time, had an average grade of 5.5

- 90% = 100 missed lessons
- 80% = 8 weeks which is 200 missed lessons
